The city of Oxford is one of the most beautiful in the world, and is a vibrant centre of both learning and culture. It has the youngest population of any city in England, but is also full of striking historic buildings dating back to the 11th century. While Oxford is surrounded by traditional countryside, it is only one hour by train to London, and has excellent connections.

Oxford University does not have a ‘campus’ as such. With most colleges and departments situated around the



city centre, the university and the city are one and the same. Amongst the University's colleges and departments, you will also find world-class libraries and museums, as well as many shops, cafés, restaurants, pubs and cinemas.

The city's splendid natural beauty and ‘green spaces’ makes it one of the most attractive places to visit in summer. You can enjoy riverside walks and punting, England's oldest Botanic Garden and of course the famous University Parks and college gardens.



VISA INFORMATION

Not all students applying for the *IELTS Intensive* will require a visa. However, for non-EU students applying from abroad, it is possible to join these programmes with either a Short-term Study Visa or a Tier 4 Visa.
